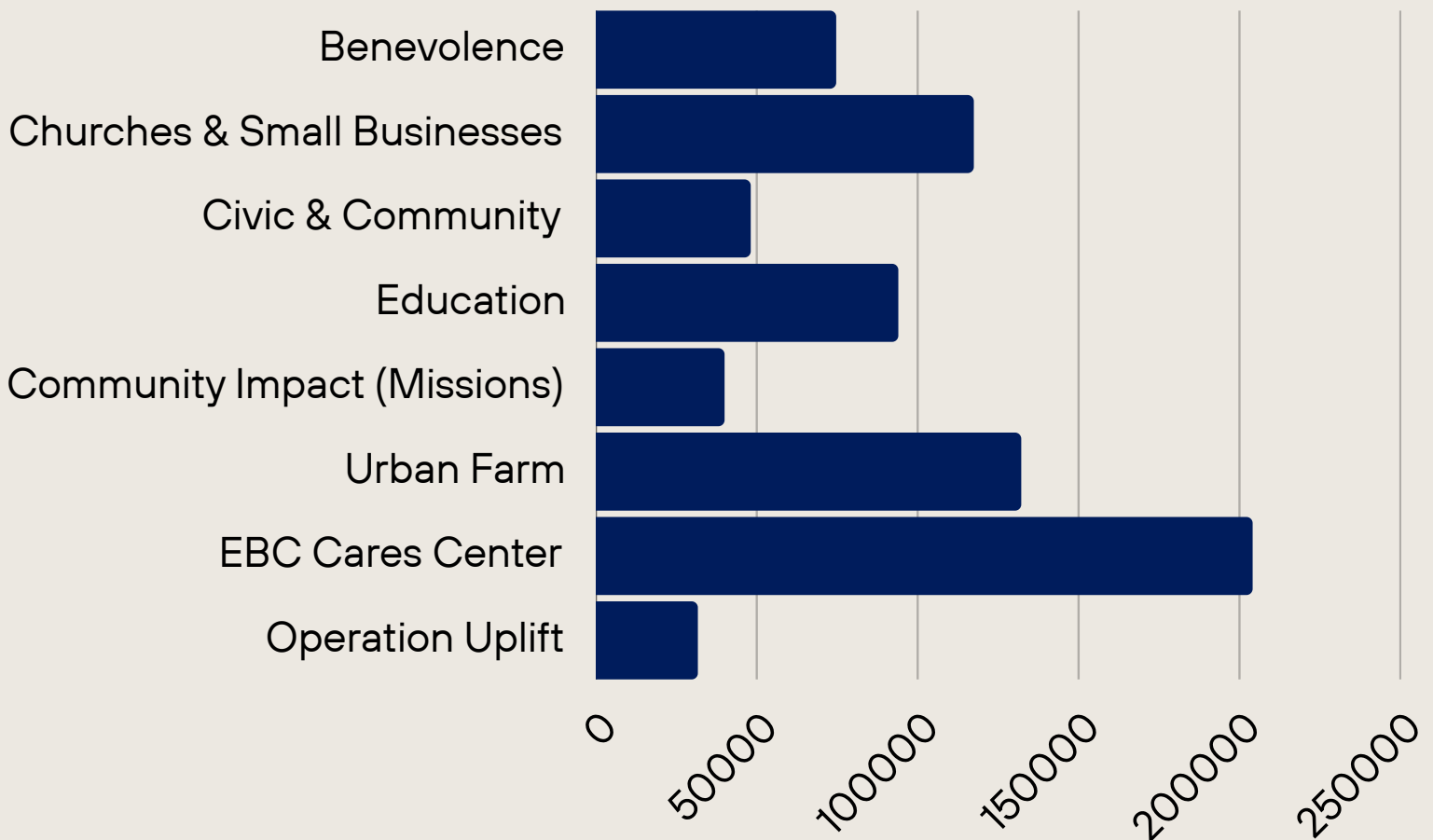

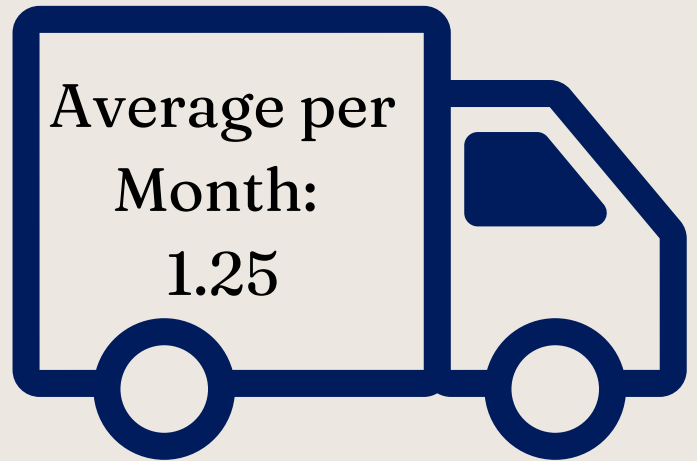

Ensuring timely and efficient shipments is crucial to our operation. This year, we have successfully increased our reach and efficiency.

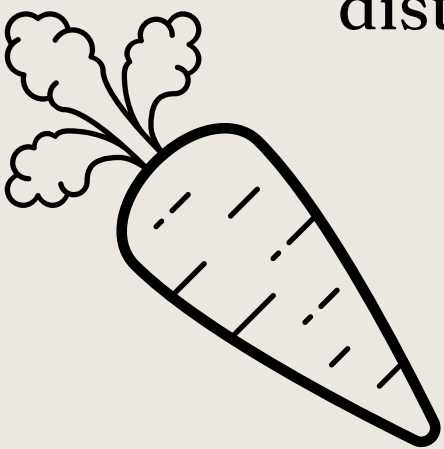
Our logistics team has worked tirelessly to ensure that all shipments are promptly processed, expanding our reach and impact.
